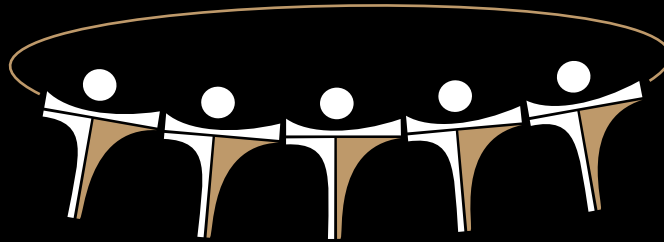

Licensing Rental Residential Housing, Bill 130

College and university communities seek to strike a balance between worthy objectives. In neighbourhoods that contribute to the supply of student housing, one objective is the maintenance of minimum health, safety and property standards. Traditional approaches to the enforcement of minimum standards are sometimes inadequate. Attendees will hear how Oshawa is seeking to address the challenge of minimum standards by implementing new municipal powers including residential rental licensing, administrative penalties and the delegation of legislative and quasi-judicial powers.
