



**By-law 103-73
of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa**

being a by-law to consolidate by-law numbers 154-67 and 102-73 to establish certain periods during which fireworks may be sold and the age of persons to whom fireworks may be sold.

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a by-law of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa by the Council thereof as follows:

1. No persons shall sell fireworks in the City of Oshawa on any days of the year from January 1st to a date six (6) days prior to the date fixed for the celebration of Victoria Day and from the day following Victoria Day to June 25th and from July 2nd to December 31st in each year.
2. No person shall sell fireworks to any person under the age of eighteen (18) years.
3. Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and liable upon conviction to a penalty not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) or more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) exclusive of costs for each offence.
4. By-law numbers 154-67 and 102-73 be and the same are hereby repealed.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed this fourteenth day of May, 1973.
