To help guide your review of the draft Oshawa Strategic Plan – *From Vision to Reality, An Action Plan for a Sustainable Oshawa*, you may wish to consider the following discussion points:

- Does the document explain the concept of sustainability clearly?
- Do you agree with/support the rationale behind “Why a Sustainable Oshawa”?
- Do you agree with/support the proposed Key Success Factors?
- Do you agree progress on the five pillars and Council's five strategic goals will help to build a sustainable Oshawa?
- Do you agree with the proposed new community vision and corporate mission statements?
- Is anything critical missing from the Action Plan which is divided into the five pillars and the five Council goals? Is there anything that needs updating or changing?
- Do you agree with Council's eight proposed priority objectives? Note the identification is based on the content of the plan, so if the content changes, the priorities may change.
- What obstacles stand in the way of Oshawa becoming a more sustainable corporation and community? What suggestions would you provide to help the City overcome these obstacles?
- Do you agree with the methodology for monitoring our progress on the plan? Are there any sustainability indicators that should be included or removed?
- Is the language used in the draft Plan clear? Are there any other words/terms that should be included in the Glossary?
