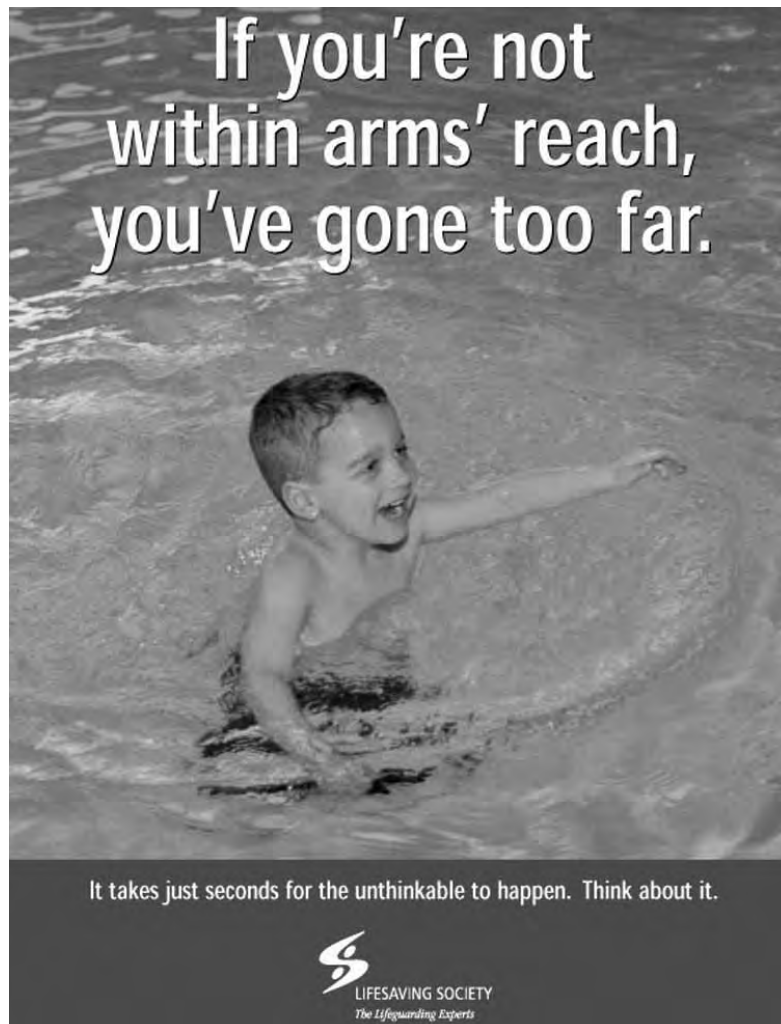

General Pool Rules

- Disposable and cloth diapers are not permitted in the water. Please use diapers designed for pool use
- All individuals with a serious medical condition should be accompanied in the water with another individual knowledgeable of their condition
- Those with open sores or communicable diseases will not be admitted to swimming pools unless a medical doctor's certificate is presented
- Shorts & cut-offs are not allowed in the pool; T-shirts may be worn over a swim suit
- Children 13 years of age and younger are not permitted in the hot tubs or saunas. Pregnant women and those with medical conditions should consult a physician before using the hot tubs or sauna
- Spectators are required to view lessons from the viewing galleries
- Please do not bring food and/or beverage onto pool decks
- Shoes must be removed before entering the shower and pool area

Changeroom Policies

Legends Centre:

- All parents and guardians with babies and children under 12 years of age **are required** to use the family changeroom
- All unaccompanied children under 12 years of age **are required** to use the family changeroom
- Adults unaccompanied by children **are required** to use the gender-specific changerooms during Fun and Leisure Swims.

Civic Recreation Complex, Donevan Recreation Complex and South Oshawa Community Centre:

- Mixed gender families **are required** to use the family changeroom
- Families of any age, of the same gender may use gender specific changerooms
- Unaccompanied children under 12 years of age **are required** to use the family changeroom
- Adults unaccompanied by children **are required** to use the gender-specific changerooms during Fun and Leisure Swims.

Grade 3 Students Are Learning Essential Swim Skills

Grade 3 students from the Durham District and the Durham Catholic District School Boards will participate in the Lifesaving Society's Swim to Survive Program in swimming pools across Durham Region during the 2011/2012 school year.

The Swim to Survive program provides the opportunity for children to learn essential skills needed to survive an unexpected fall into deep water:

ROLL into deep water, TREAD water for one minute and SWIM 50 metres

The City of Oshawa is proud to be part of a partnership with the Town of Whitby, the Town of Ajax, City of Pickering, Township of Uxbridge, the Durham Family YMCA, the Eastview Boys & Girls Club and the two School Boards to bring this program to the Grade 3 children in Durham Region.
