Join us at 155 Arena Street for the following:

In Children's Arena:

- Canadian Peony Society's Peony Show
- Demonstrations
- Washrooms

At the front of Children's Arena, catch a shuttle bus to off-site parking and Parkwood Estate.

At the official entrance to the Peony Garden:

- Welcome table
- Canadian Peony Society's booth
- Durham Master Gardeners' booth

Along the creek pathway will be a variety of Artists in the Park and garden related vendors, as well as the Peony Café.

Other areas of interest in the garden include:

- The Rockery with waterfall
- Rotary Bridge

Across the bridge, stroll through:

- Annual Floral Displays
- Memory Garden

Paths to the north lead to the Parkwood site and paths to the south lead to the Robert McLaughlin Gallery and the parking garage.

Directions

From Highway 401, take the Simcoe Street North exit. Travel north through downtown Oshawa to Adelaide Avenue and turn left. Travel west on Adelaide to Arena Street and turn left. Landmarks on either side of the Gardens will be Children's Arena and Kinsmen Stadium.

Parking

- Limited parking is available on-site at 155 Arena Street.
- Limited street parking is available in the area.
- The Parking Garage at Bond Street West and MacMillan Drive will be open at no charge. The Gardens are a five minute walk north.
- Volunteers will be on-site with parking directions and instructions.

Shuttle

A shuttle service will run between the Gardens, Parkwood and the parking garage from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm each day.
