According to Section 14 of the Act, a head shall refuse to disclose personal information to any individual other than to whom the information relates.


According to authority to delegate under the Act, I have responsibility for this decision.

Arrived on location with 2 people trapped in the elevator. There was no supervisor or building manager on scene. Made contact with the trapped personnel who were between the first and second floor. Victims were agitated and panicking . We removed keys from supra key box. No keys would fit the mechanical room beside the elevator. Repeated attempts were made by dispatch and alarm company to notify a key holder. In the electrical room we turned the breaker off for the elevator but it had no effect. There was no elevator contact numbers anywhere in that room. We opened up the outer doors to the elevator. After an hour and a half one of the victims started having difficulty breathing, we then bent the inside doors and removed the personnel from the elevator. We taped off the elevator on all floors and left a notice to occupant on the main floor. Two contacts numbers were give to us from the trapped personnel which I sent to dispatch.
