Re: FOI Request 2018-138 - Notice of Decision

This is in response to your request made under the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.56 (the "Act") for a copy of the Municipal Law Enforcement report that relates to a dog bite that occurred at Harmony Valley Dog Park on March 11, 2018.
