
# WINDFIELDS CONNECTION WINDFIELDS FARM DRIVE WEST TO WINCHESTER ROAD WEST Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Notice of Study Commencement

## Introduction

The City of Oshawa has initiated a Study for a new collector road from Windfields Farm Drive West to Winchester Road West known as the Windfields Connection. This Harmonized Environmental Assessment (E.A.) Study will examine alignment, cross section, intersection and active transportation alternatives and recommend a preferred alternative to address the needs of the Study Area. The Study will also determine any property acquisition required to implement the project.

## **Study Process**

The Windfields Connection E.A. Study is being conducted as a harmonized: Category B Public Work Class E.A. Study under the Ministry of Infrastructure Public Work Class Environmental Assessment (2012) / Schedule B Municipal Class E.A. Study under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2015). The Study will complete the phases of both Class E.A.s by establishing the need and justification for the project, considering all reasonable alternatives with acceptable effects on the natural, social and cultural environments, and proactively involving the public, agencies and indigenous communities.

All information will be collected in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of *Privacy Act* (2009). With the exception of personal information, all comments will become part of the public record. Persons will be advised of future communication opportunities by electronic notice.
