

## **Appointment of Citizens to Committees**

## **Hearings Officer**

The Hearings Officer position is established for the purpose of exercising delegated powers of decision. Preference is given to eligible candidates with knowledge of and experience in administrative law and of good character. In accordance with the By-law, the following persons are not eligible to be appointed as a Hearings Officer:

- an employee or member of Council of the City;
- the child, parent or spouse of an employee or member of Council; or,
- a person indebted to the City (other than in respect of current real property taxes or pursuant to an agreement with the City the terms with which the person is in compliance). (One vacancy to November 2026)

## **Oshawa Environmental Advisory Committee**

Assist, advise and educate City Council, staff, and the community with respect to the protection, enhancement, restoration, management and appreciation of the natural and built environments. (One vacancy to November 2024)

## **Oshawa Accessibility Advisory Committee**

Advise and assist the City of Oshawa in developing and facilitating strategies and actions towards a barrier-free Oshawa. Members include persons with disabilities, parents representing children with disabilities and individuals interested in issues related to persons with disabilities. (One vacancy to November 2024).
