

Appointment of Citizens to Committees

The appointment of Oshawa citizens and stakeholders to boards and committees give the public an opportunity to volunteer their skills and time to deal with various issues associated with our City. Meetings are held electronically using a hybrid format.

City Council will consider the names of Oshawa citizens and stakeholders who wish to stand for appointment. An application form must be completed with a resume attached and is available on the [Committees webpage](#). The deadline for receipt of completed application forms is 4:30 p.m., Friday, April 21, 2023.

Hearings Officer

The Hearings Officer position is established for the purpose of exercising delegated powers of decision. Preference is given to eligible candidates with knowledge of and experience in administrative law and of good character. In accordance with the By-law, the following persons are not eligible to be appointed as a Hearings Officer:

- an employee or member of Council of the City;
- the child, parent or spouse of an employee or member of Council; or,
- a person indebted to the City (other than in respect of current real property taxes or pursuant to an agreement with the City the terms with which the person is in compliance). (One vacancy to November 2026)

Oshawa Animal Care Advisory Committee

To assist, advise and educate City Council, staff, key stakeholders and the wider Oshawa community with respect to continually improving the efficient and compassionate care of animals within the City of Oshawa. A key part of OACAC's function will be to: find and evaluate potential initiatives; provide expert opinions and network with other subject matter experts on issues; assist and promote existing and future projects; support fundraising and grant applications; and facilitate training of stakeholders and the general public.
