- A question was raised about the City's plan to rename the Northview Community Centre after a prior council member.
  - The City is working on developing a naming process to create a more standardize approach for addressing upcoming name changes (e.g., Bagot street).
- Committee discussed the potential of an in-person April meeting. Staff will reach out by email to obtain input for the potential meeting.
  - Committee members noted that a central location and a potentially earlier start time should be considered when planning the meeting.

• The Committee will consider any changes to the structure and format of the meetings once a few in-person meetings have been held and members can reflect on what is and is not working.

- To support planning for upcoming months/days of significance, volunteers will be asked to support two sub-committees: Pride Month and National Indigenous History Month and Indigenous Peoples Day.
