- "I move a motion that CDEIC pass a resolution recommending to the City of Oshawa that the Medicine Wheel flag representing the Indigenous Peoples of Canada be flown at city Hall from this year onward".
  - Discussion surrounding why the Medicine Wheel flag is the recommendation in this instance
  - Donald explained that the colour symbolism of the wheel is a representation of all races
  - Julie described that there will be a fulsome recommendation put forth to Council in terms of Truth and Reconciliation, with just community consultation
  - This topic is deferred to next meeting, as quorum was not achieved.
  - Discussion of enhancing the significant meaning behind Orange Shirt Day this year
