Demolition or Moving of Buildings

Permit Application

A permit application form must be fully completed and signed by the registered owner of the land or his/her agent authorized in writing. The application must be accompanied by the required permit fee and plans.

Disconnection of Services

When demolishing or moving a building a **Notice to Disconnect Services** form must be completed and signed by the appropriate authorities prior to the issuance of a demolition permit. (Refer to Page 4)

Moving of Buildings

The Highway Traffic Act provides that the municipality, having jurisdiction over highways to be occupied, may issue a moving permit. This permit must be obtained from authorities having jurisdiction over all roads to be used for the move. (Refer to Page 4)

Where the building is to be moved to another property within the City of Oshawa limits, a separate building permit for foundations on the new location must be obtained prior to the issuance of a moving permit.

Heritage Oshawa

Where applicable, notice to Heritage Oshawa must be signed off by its official prior to the issuance of a demolition permit if the building/structure is on the Heritage Oshawa's Inventory. (Refer to Page 4)

Permit Fee

Initial permit fee shall be calculated in accordance with Schedule D of Building By-law No. 33-2009. Personal cheques payable to "City of Oshawa", cash, debit, and credit card are acceptable for payment of permit fee.

Other Fee

Where applicable, the following fee must be collected by the Building Permit Services prior to the issuance of a building/demolition permit:

- Road Restoration Deposit: \$18.00 per 1.0 metre of street line.
- Personal cheques payable to City of Oshawa, cash or debit are acceptable for payment of the above funds.

Demolishing Partial Building

Where applicable, the following certificates, reports and/or plans prepared by a professional engineer or architect shall be provided prior to the issuance of a demolition permit:

- Structural adequacy of the remaining building including proposed work required.
- Fire safety systems of the remaining building including proposed work required.

Demolition Permit Information

The owner or authorized agent must complete and sign the **Demolition Permit Information** form on Page 3 prior to the issuance of a demolition permit.

Certain types of construction or renovations that involve excavations that change the site grading may require approval from the City of Oshawa's Engineering Services in conjunction to the Site Alteration By-law 85-2006. For further information call 905-436-3311, extension 2594 or 2386.

2012 Ontario Building Code Requirements

Div. C, 1.2.2.3.(1) The applicant for a permit respecting the *demolition* of a *building* shall retain a *professional engineer* to undertake the general review of the project during *demolition*, where,

- (a) the *building* exceeds three (3) *storeys* in *building height* or 600 square metres (6459 square feet) in *building area*,
- (b) the building structure includes pre-tensioned or post-tensioned members,
- (c) it is proposed that the *demolition* will extend below the level of the footings of any adjacent *building* and occur within the angle of repose of the *soil*, as drawn from the bottom of such footings, or
- (d) explosives or a laser are to be used during the course of *demolition*.

Div. C, 1.3.1.1.(1)(a) A person is exempt from the requirement to obtain a permit under section 8 of the Act for the *demolition of a building* located on a farm.

Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations (OHSAR)

In accordance with OHSAR, it is the responsibility of the building owner to ensure the safety of workers from hazardous materials.
