Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 Integrated Accessibility Standards Regulation – Ontario Regulation 191/11 conforming to the World Wide Web Consortium’s Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (W.C.A.G.) 2.0 Level AA.

The City of Oshawa documents must also:

1. Pass the “Full Check” in Adobe Acrobat DC;
2. Have the correct reading order;
3. Have a logical structure in the tag tree and at least one Heading 1;
4. Include Bookmarks
5. Include alternative text tags and a detailed description of any image/table; and
6. Have an Accessibility Report attached to the file.
