

## Coniferous Tree Planting on Slope



## Notes:

- 1. ALL DIMENSIONS ARE IN MILLIMETERS.
- ALL PLANT MATERIAL TO CONFORM TO THE CANADIAN NURSERY STOCK STANDARD, LATEST EDITION, PUBLISHED BY THE CANADIAN NURSERY LANDSCAPE ASSOCIATION.
- 3. ENSURE TREES ARE THOROUGHLY WATERED AT TIME OF PLANTING. CONTINUE WATERING AS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE MOISTURE TO THE TREE FOR THE DURATION OF THE SPECIFIED MAINTENANCE PERIOD.
- REMOVE ALL TAGS, TAPES AND WRAPS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING FINAL INSPECTION.
- 5. TREE IS TO BE STAKED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING PLANTING. RUBBER HOSE SHALL BE USED AS A COVER OVER #10 GAUGE WIRE TO PROTECT THE TREE BARK FROM DAMAGE. THE RUBBER HOSE SHALL BE CUT TO A SUFFICIENT LENGTH TO LOOSELY ENCIRCLE THE TREE TRUNK. STAKES SHALL BE INSTALLED PLUMB AT A HEIGHT OF 1500mm AND PARALLEL TO PREVAILING WIND PATTERNS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING AND DISPOSING THE STAKES AND WIRE 12 MONTHS FOLLOWING THE INSTALLATION OF THE TREE.
- 6. PLANTING SOIL MIXTURE AS PER SPECIFICATION.
- 7. REFER TO THE STREET TREE PLANTING LAYOUT DETAIL P611 FOR NEW DEVELOPMENTS FOR OFFSETS FROM OTHER ELEMENTS.
